

Results of Vice Mayor Griffith's 2013 Study Issue Survey

Introduction

The survey was conducted between January 11th and January 27th, 2013. 85 responses were received. Note that the following five study issues were added to the list of potential study issues by staff after some participants had already voted, and one of them was reclassified in a different department:

CDD 13-14	City Options for Funding a Homeless Shelter and/or Other Solutions to Homelessness
CDD 13-15	Measures for Preserving Affordable Housing as an Alternative to Rent Control
DPW 13-15	Protecting Burrowing Owl Habitat on City Facilities
ESD 13-06	Cost/Benefits of Notifying City Water Customers on Their Bills About the Potential Health Effects of Putting Fluoridated Water In Baby Formula (was FIN)
OCM 13-03	Cost/Benefits of Renting the Civic Center Space Compared with Renovating to Like-new Condition the Current Space and the Cost of Replacing the "Rabbit Hutches" with a Bigger Building and Underground Parking

This should be taken into account when viewing the results for the study issues for the Office of the City Attorney.

The survey mimicks the voting mechanism that Council uses in ranking study issues. Participants were provided with the study issue overviews as described in the council overview sheets, with links to the full write-ups. Participants were first asked to indicate which study issues should be dropped. Of what remained, participants were asked to indicate which study issues should be deferred until next year. Of what remained, participants were asked to rank their top four choices (or fewer, if a department had less than four study issues). The raw votes cast are on the final page of the summary. Each department is broken down into four results. The first set of results orders study issues by residents' preference for dropping issues, with items most favored to be dropped listed first. The second set shows the preference for deferring issues, with items most favored to be deferred listed first. **Note that since respondents first voted for dropping issues and then deferring, items favored to be dropped score low on the deferral list.** As such, the best measure of a study issue's unpopularity is its drop percentage plus its deferral percentage, resulting in a "rank/do not rank" value.

The third and fourth sets indicate the preferred ranking order of the study issues, in two ways.

In the "drop-weighted ranking", study issues are ranked, but "drop" and "defer" votes are applied as a negative value. As such, the "drop-weighted ranking" attempts to represent the collective opinion of all survey participants. This can be interpreted as "deciding to vote to represent the wishes of the resident".

In the "rank only" ranking, study issues are ranked ignoring all "drop" and "defer" votes. As such, the "ignore drop/defer votes" ranking is best described as "when participants value an issue, how strongly they value it". This can be interpreted as "having decided to rank items, vote according to this order".

Overall trends

Unlike past years, respondents were all over the place this year, with no strong preferences. Two or three study issues were clearly unpopular, two or three study issues were clearly popular, and the rest showed fairly uniform distribution between ranking, deferring, or dropping. "Popular" is defined by the issues' drop-weighted scores.
